 purpose hereof Reserving what ever any other Will or

 affirm and declare that the agreement of partnership and

 declaration in his last Will and Testament made the beginning
 of the year one thousand six hundred ninety six and by Don
 George Ashenden and Wirrall his last Will and Testament
 made in June last past one thousand seven hundred and two
 and his Lady Jefferys Widow to Sr Thomas mi Son^o and Laura
 Paulin y Jefferys her last Will and Testament made in August
